WHEREAS, Workforce Development is Everyone’s Business™; and

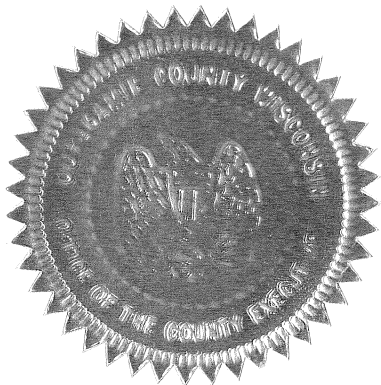
